Regional Market Watch

[Approved vendor lists \(AVLs\)](#) are increasingly shaping the U.S. residential solar market by restricting projects to financier-vetted equipment. After the 30% residential tax credit (25D) ended in 2025, many installers shifted to third-party owned (TPO) systems like leases and PPAs that still qualify for the 48E commercial credit. Because financiers own and guarantee these systems, installers must use AVL-approved components, reducing risk but limiting product choice and complicating procurement. New foreign entity of concern (FEOC) rules—requiring at least 40% of components from non-restricted manufacturers—have further narrowed equipment options, especially modules, pushing the market toward financier-controlled TPO models.



